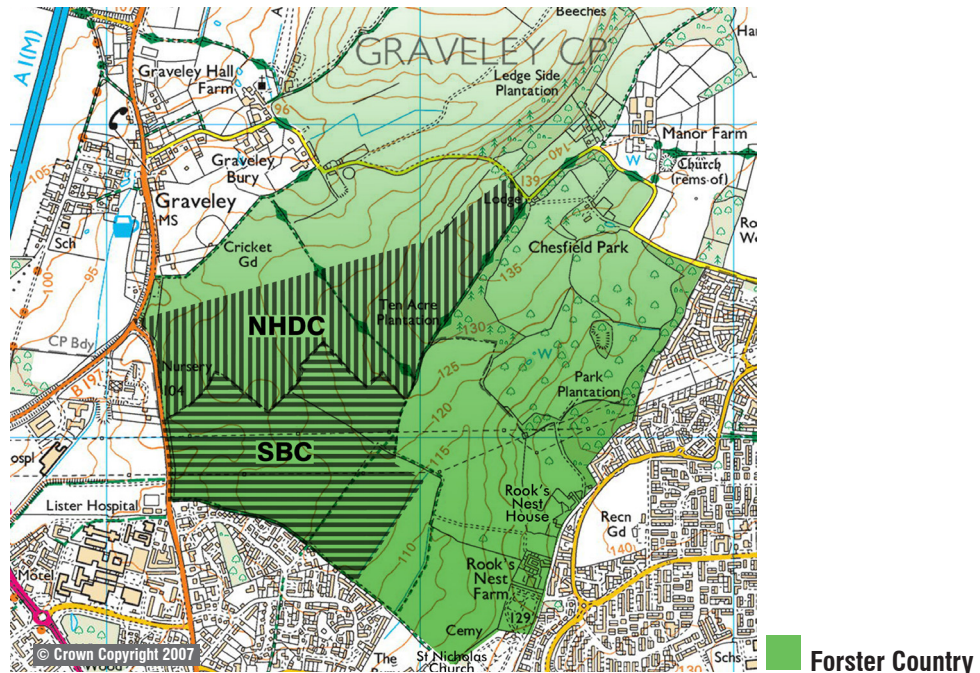

SBC have now published the latest Local Plan for consultation.

Their intention is to build housing in an area north of St Nicholas Church up to the Stevenage boundary. At present this plan has not been approved, but unless people object to the proposal in large numbers it will almost certainly go ahead, with immense loss of amenity for ALL of Stevenage. NHDC have also proposed building on the adjacent area to the north. The combined proposal is indicated on the map above.
